It was sent to libraries and individual receivers from over 50 countries of the world. Texts of all papers are available on-line at suitable webpages and the journal is began to be cited by the most popular abstracting services. All this forecasts further good development. Hoping for it, I thank all the readers, authors, reviewers, members of the International Editorial Board, Deputies Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editors and all those thanks to whose work the tasks of the journal could have been done during the current year.
